

Wedding Music Contract

- Event package includes one phone consultation with Chuck Callahan, owner and lead musician, and one standard ceremony performance. A standard ceremony consists of the following:
 - 30 minutes of prelude music, processionals, music for mid-ceremony rituals, recessional, and postlude.
- If there is a song you'd like our musicians to play during your event that is not currently in our repertoire, we can usually find an arrangement. The additional cost for each new arrangement is \$25.
- We require you provide one chair, without arms, for each member of the ensemble. If you are requesting electric instruments, we ask that you provide a power source as well. Our musicians will provide their own music stands.
- Chuck Callahan, owner and lead musician, will supply other musicians as needed. All other musicians will be booked through Chuck Callahan.
- It is understood that some musical instruments, particularly string instruments, are extremely valuable and are susceptible to damage when exposed to certain climatic variations, such as rain. Therefore the performers must be provided with shelter from rain or any inclement weather.
- If your event starts more than 30 minutes late, overtime will be billed at the rate of \$_____ per half hour.

- A non-refundable 20% deposit is due with your contract to secure your date on the calendar. The remaining balance is due at least one week before the wedding.
- Acceptable forms of payment include cash, check, or any major credit card. Payments made by card will be susceptible to a small processing fee. All checks can be made payable to Chuck Callahan.
- If due to vehicular accident, severe weather, or medical emergency one or more of our musicians are unable to attend an event, the aforementioned payments will be refunded and the musician(s) will not be liable for any damages resulting from this failure to perform.
- If your event is cancelled, Chuck Callahan, lead musician, will need at least 30 days notice or you will still be responsible to pay the full balance.
